Remember, these pledges are payable over a five-year period, and pledges are not legally binding. They are made in good faith and may be altered at any time if your personal situation changes.
- **♥** [HOLD UP THE ENVELOPE] Please take a moment and review the example pledges.
- Please select one of the suggested pledge levels. The average pledge to our campaign has been \$[AVERAGE PLEDGE] which is [\$MONTHLY PAYMENT] each month.
- Please be sure to write the total amount of your pledge on the line provided.
- Finally, check how you would like to make payments on your pledge yearly or monthly or other. The Archdiocese will send reminders based on your preference.
- If you are unable to decide now, please mark the card appropriately.
- Please seal the envelope and pass it to the aisle. Ushers are making their way around to collect all completed cards.
- Thank you! I will announce our updated campaign totals at all Masses next weekend.
