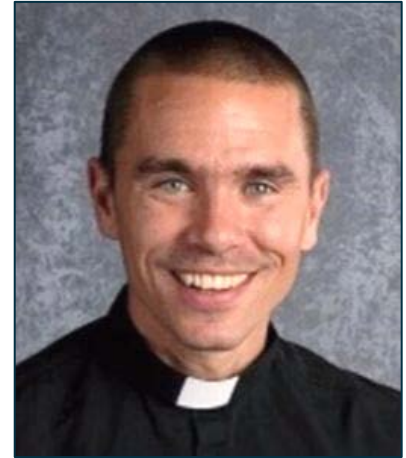
Almighty and ever-living God,

Love One Another Case

\$150 million goal

- ♥ Strengthening 189 Parishes: \$90 million
- ♥ Serving and Helping those in Need: \$13.5 million
- ♥ Supporting our Priests, Deacons, Seminarians, and Lay Ministers: \$13 million
- ♥ Supporting Catholic Schools: \$17 million
- ♥ Strengthening Centers of Prayer and Ministry: \$16.5 million

Campaign Progress

- ♥ On parish goals totaling \$31 Million, we have received pledges that total \$40.7 million.
- ♥ Wave 2:
 - ♥ 60 Parishes
 - ♥ \$56.2 Million Goal

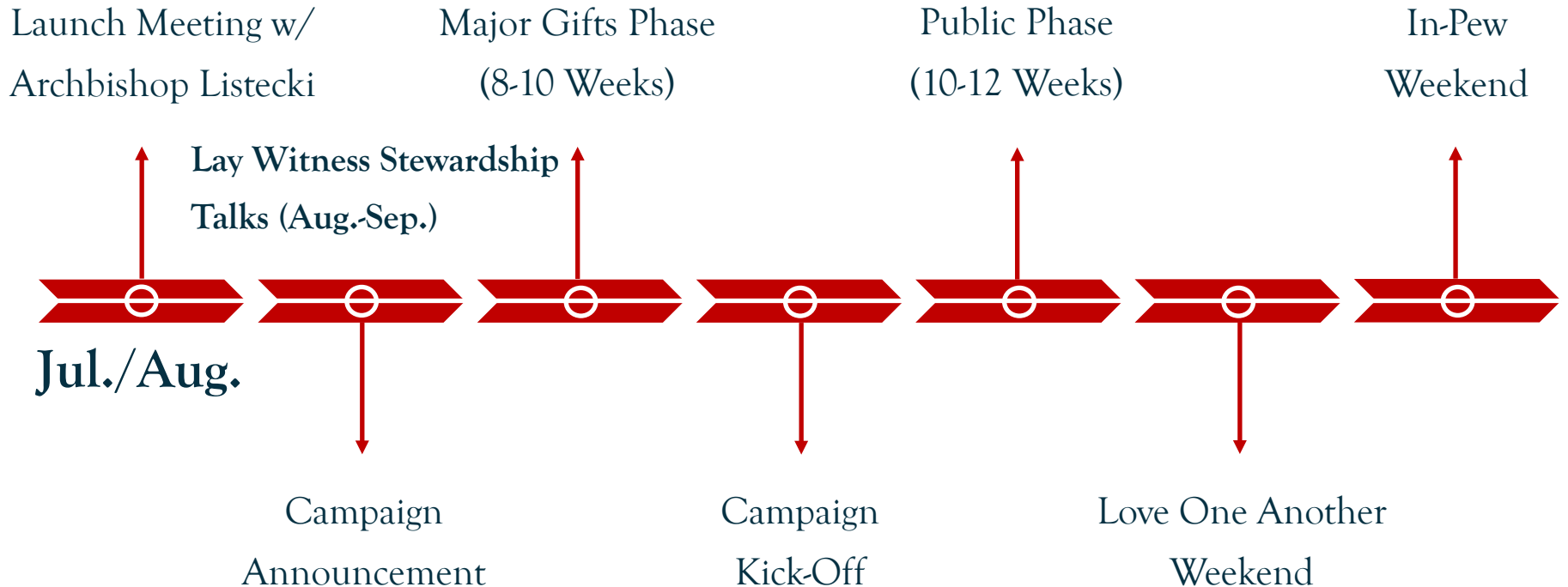
